## RECORDING A GERMAN-PAPERED HANOVERIAN

Horses holding a pink certificate of registration issued by the German Hanoverian Society (Verband Hannoverscher Warmblutzüchter) must be recorded into the American Hanoverian Society's database in order to compete for breed awards, come in for inspection, or register offspring from this horse.

1. **THE ORIGINAL CERTIFICATE OF REGISTRATION MUST BE SUBMITTED TO THE AHS OFFICE.** It is strongly suggested that all German papers be sent via Certified Mail.
2. A name must be declared for the horse according to the naming policy of the AHS at the time of recording. Mares already in the German Studbook will have their registered name typed on their papers, and this is the name which will be maintained. Names handwritten on the papers are not considered official. In general, the name must start with the first letter of the sire's name. Certain "W" line horses have reverted to the "F" line, so please check with the AHS Office if this applies to your horse. The name may not exceed 20 characters, including spaces and punctuation, and must be unique. You need not show your horse under its registered name.
3. There is a one-time recording fee of \$ 60.00 for current members of the AHS. You must become a member at the time of recording. Fees are subject to change.

## **MEMBERSHIP INFORMATION**

### **NON-MEMBERS PAY DOUBLE FEES**

Membership in the American Hanoverian Society, Inc. provides discounted fees for all services, such as recording of German Hanoverians, Transfers of Ownership, etc., provided by the Society.

The Society offers several forms of membership. All memberships are valid for the calendar year.

**ACTIVE:** *Required* for those breeding Hanoverians, registering foals, presenting mares or stallions at Inspection or for mares registered in a section of the studbook. Receive the AHS Newsletter, Stallion Directory, and English translation of the German publication. Eligible for all Awards programs. Eligible to vote on Society matters.

**DUES:** Active member                      \$80.00

**ASSOCIATE:** Recommended for those primarily showing (not breeding) their Hanoverians. Receive the AHS Newsletter. Eligible for all Awards Programs. May purchase Stallion Directory at a reduced price. (Associate members under the age of 21 are eligible for the USDF Junior/Young riders program).

**DUES:** Associate member                      \$55.00

**LIFE:** Receive all benefits of Active Membership, but do not pay personal dues yearly. Must still pay any horse dues for breeding animals yearly.

**DUES:** Life member                              \$800.00

**JUNIOR:** For youths under the age of 21. Same benefits as Associate Members.

**DUES:** Junior member                              \$25.00

### **FORMS OF OWNERSHIP:**

The American Hanoverian Society recognizes several forms of recorded ownership: Individual, Joint (two related individuals), Partnership (two or more unrelated individuals), and Corporate (farm and business). Consider the form of ownership that best applies to your situation at the time of recording, and make your application for membership exactly as you wish it to appear on the horse's papers.

### **BYLAWS, RULES AND REGULATIONS**

All persons doing business with the AHS are subject to the Bylaws, Breeding Rules and Regulations, and all procedural policies adopted by the society. These may change from time to time, so all persons are advised to check with the Society for current information. All fees are subject to change.
