### **MEMBERSHIP INFORMATION**

Membership in the American Hanoverian Society, Inc. provides discounted fees for services such as recording of German Hanoverians, Transfers of Ownerships, etc. provided by the Society. The Society offers several forms of membership. ALL MEMBERSHIPS ARE VALID FOR A CALENDAR YEAR.

#### TYPES OF MEMBERSHIP:

<u>ACTIVE:</u> *Required* for those breeding Hanoverians, registering foals, or presenting mares or stallions at inspection to be entered into the AHS breeding program. Active members are eligible for AHS awards programs, may serve on committees and vote. They receive the annual AHS Stallion Directory.

**DUES: Active Member \$80.00** 

**REGULAR:** Members who are not participating in the AHS breeding program but are eligible for AHS awards, may hold office, serve on committees and vote. Regulat members receive the annual AHS Stallion Directory.

**DUES: Regular Member \$80.00** 

**ASSOCIATE:** Recommended for those primarily showing (not breeding) their Hanoverians. Associate members are eligible for all AHS awards programs. Associate members may purchase an AHS Stallion Directory at a reduced price.

**DUES: Associate Member \$55.00** 

**LIFE:** Receive all benefits of Active Membership, but do not pay personal dues yearly. Life members must still pay any horse dues for breeding animals yearly.

**DUES: Life Member \$800.00** 

**JUNIOR**: For members under the age of 21 as of January 1st of the current year. Junior members receive the same benefits as Associate Members.

**DUES: Junior Member \$25.00** 

## **TYPES OF OWNERSHIP**

The American Hanoverian Society recognizes several types of ownership: Individual, Joint (two related individuals), Partnership (two or more unrelated individuals), Corporate (farm or business). Consider the form of ownership that best applies to your situation at the time of joining, and make your application for membership exactly as you wish it to appear on the horse's papers. Please keep in mind, when two individuals are listed as owners, if "and" is connecting the two names (e.g. John and Susie Smith), both are required to sign in order to release the ownership of the horse to the new owner(s). If "and/or" is used, parties (e.g. John and/or Susie Smith), then only one signature is required.

# **BYLAWS, RULES AND REGULATIONS**

All persons doing business with the AHS are subject to the Bylaws, Breeding Rules and Regulations, and all procedural policies adopted by the society. These may change from time to time, so all persons are advised to check with the Society for current information. All fees are subject to change.
